Participation in the Junior Counselor program is by selection. Those interested in the program must complete an application process, which includes an application, references, and an interview.

Applicants must possess a genuine interest in youth development and in working with younger children and be willing to commit the required energy, enthusiasm and cooperation in all aspects of the program. A positive and cooperative attitude and pleasant disposition are critical personal attributes for the position.

Applicants should ask themselves the following questions:

- ➤ Do I have a sincere desire to work with children?
- ➤ Would I like the opportunity to develop and improve my leadership ability?
- Am I ready to become a role model for younger children?
- ➤ Can I handle the responsibility of being a junior counselor?
- ➤ Do I have the ability to work well with others in a variety of situations?

If the applicant answered yes to the above questions, the Junior Counselor program may be an opportunity to gain valuable experience in a fun-filled environment.
