HTML (Hypertext Markup Language) is the language used to make a web page. HTML tells your browser how the web page should appear. It's the "source code" of a web page. As computer languages go, HTML is relatively simple. Anyone can learn it. HTML is a set of special codes, called tags, that are used to markup plain text so that a browser application, such as IE or Firefox, knows how to display the text in the browser window. Before you can begin to understand Dreamweaver, a WYSIWYG editor, you must learn the basics of web design and HTML. You will complete the following exercises:
