Sarah J. Meyland is a water specialist with a background in groundwater protection, water resources management, and environmental law. Presently Ms. Meyland is an Associate Professor in the Department of Environmental Technology, School of Engineering and Computing Sciences, where she teaches in the Masters of Science Program at New York Institute of Technology. Additionally, she serves as the Director for the Center for Water Resources Management. She has a dual appointment with the Center for Global Health.

Professor Meyland has worked in New York State government as the Co-Executive Director of the NYS Legislative Commission on Water Resource Needs of Long Island, as the Watershed Director for the Suffolk County Water Authority and as Program Coordinator for the Nassau County Planning Federation.
